Junior Counselor

APPLICANT MUST:

- Have completed at least 7th grade as of June 2020.
- Understand that this is a volunteer position.

PURPOSE:

- Care for the physical & spiritual needs of the camper.
- Assist the counselor in his/her responsibilities.
- Cooperate with other CITs and Day Camp staff.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Be actively involved in YOUR OWN daily quiet time, maintaining spiritual growth.
- Participate in Counselor Training on Sunday, June 28 from 2 – 5 pm.
- Attend CIT Dinner Party on Tuesday, July 7 and Tuesday, July 14.
- Commit to being “hands on” at Beacon from 8 am – 4 pm July 6 – 10 and July 13 – 17.
- Attend Leadership Meet and Greet on May 17 from 5 – 6 pm
- Learn the names of all 12 of your campers.
- Be an active participant in singing, small group time, electives, etc.

Senior Counselor

APPLICANT MUST:

- Have completed at least 9th grade as of June 2020.
- Have had at least 1 year working at Beacon Day Camp.
- Be 21 years old or younger. (Over 21? You can be a volunteer elective teacher!)
- Have a strong desire to see campers come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

PURPOSE:

- Care for the physical & spiritual needs of the camper.
- Help teach (by example) your CIT to lead.
- Cooperate with other counselors and Day Camp staff.
- Generate enthusiasm for each day’s theme & activities.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Be actively involved in YOUR OWN daily quiet time, maintaining spiritual growth.
- Participate in Counselor Training on Sunday, June 28 from 2 – 5 pm.
- Commit to being “hands on” at Beacon from 8 am – 4 pm July 6 – 10 and July 13 – 17.
- Attend Leadership Meet and Greet May 17 from 5 – 6 pm.
- Attend Counselor Dinner Parties on July 9 and 16.
- Learn the names of all 12 of your campers.
- Report any problems/concerns *immediately* to Laura.
- Adhere to daily schedule, making sure your campers are on-time to scheduled activities and where they are supposed to be.
- Maintain responsibility for the health & safety of the 12 campers in your group.
- Be an active participant in singing, small group time, electives, etc.
- Always seek opportunities for sharing Jesus Christ with campers on a one-to-one basis.
- Be flexible and available wherever needed!
